**WHEREAS**, the Winston-Salem/Forsyth County Board of Education requests that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners approve a purchase price of Three Hundred-One Thousand Six-Hundred Dollars (\$301,600.00) as the amount to be spent to purchase the above-described real property;
