## RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT DETENTION CENTER WALK THROUGH BODY SCANNER (FORSYTH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE)

**WHEREAS** on September 17, 2020, bid invitations for the purchase of a walk through body scanner at the Forsyth County Law Enforcement Detention Center (LEDC) were issued directly to a total of twelve (12) qualified businesses, advertised on the City of Winston-Salem and Forsyth County websites, as well as the State's Purchasing website;

**WHEREAS** on October 6, 2020, bids were received and publicly opened by the City/County Purchasing Department at 10:00 a.m.;

**WHEREAS** one bid was received from Tek84 Inc. in the amount of \$149,000;

**WHEREAS** it is the recommendation of the County Manager, the Sheriff, and the Purchasing Director that a contract be awarded to Tek84 Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$149,000; and

**WHEREAS** the cost of this equipment will be funded by State Criminal Alien Assistant Program (SCAAP) funds;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that a contract for the purchase of a walk through body scannerat the Forsyth County Law Enforcement Detention Center, is hereby awarded to Tek84 Inc. in an amount not to exceed\$149,000 and that the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, a contract with Tek84 Inc. for the purchase of a walk through body scanner at the Forsyth County Law Enforcement Detention Center, pursuant to the terms of the bid, at a cost not to exceed \$149,000, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
