

## Farm City Photo Contest

The N.C. Cooperative Extension, Forsyth County Center is holding a Farm City Photography Contest through October 1, 2020. All professional and amateur photographers with high-quality images of agricultural activities and scenes are encouraged to enter. Images can include farms, agricultural landscapes, farm equipment, farmers, livestock, horticulture, forestry, farmer's markets, food processing, beekeeping, and other agricultural-related scenes.

Images including people should include a photo release.

Cooperative Extension, Forsyth County Center, 1450 Fairchild Road, Winston-Salem, NC 27105, scan and email it as a pdf to <a href="mailto:coop-ext-registration@forsyth.cc">coop-ext-registration@forsyth.cc</a> or hand-deliver it Monday - Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. All releases must be received by October 1, 2020, to be eligible for prizes. In addition, all photographers must sign the photo release at the end of this submission.

Photos may be in color, black and white or sepia and should be in JPG or PNG formats. Photos should be at least 150 dots per inch for large reproduction.

Images should be taken either in Forsyth County or of images in Forsyth County (example - you are taking the photograph in another county of the "Forsyth County" sign in front of a hayfield.)

Photographers do NOT have to reside in Forsyth County.

All photos selected for display or in marketing by the N.C. Cooperative Extension, Forsyth County Center will have signage identifying the photographer and will include descriptive information submitted by the photographer. The county will not identify any private image location by exact address but may list names of farms, businesses, communities, etc.

Prizes will be awarded to the winning photographs. Prize awards will be determined by the number of entries. In addition, winning entries will be utilized in Extension publications and as office decor for the Forsyth County Agricultural Building.
