Advanced Severe Weather Spotter Training

The National Weather Service will present the Advanced SKYWARN Severe Weather Spotter program. The class is designed to help students better understand the meteorology and dynamics behind all types of severe weather. The class will provide insight into the thunderstorm spectrum and how and why different types of storms develop. Instruction includes the following...

- * relation of instability to updraft intensity
- * wind shear impact on storm behavior and severity
- * radar clues and detection or severe and tornadic storms
- * processes necessary for tornado development
- * weather patterns conducive to severe weather outbreaks
